

Electoral Legacies of War: Political Competition in Postwar Southeast Europe

ELWar Expert Survey Trend File Codebook







The dataset *ELWar expert survey - Trend File* contains the combined data from the 2018 and 2020 ELWar expert surveys on parties' political ideology, policy positions, and behavior in six countries in South-East Europe: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Montenegro, and Serbia. In 2018, 73 experts estimated the positions of 70 political parties, and in 2020, 121 experts estimated the positions of 63 political parties

These surveys were conducted by Christophe Lesschaeve, Josip Glaurdić, and Michal Mochtak as part of the ELWar project – Electoral Legacies of War: Political Competition in Postwar Southeast Europe. This project, hosted by the University of Luxembourg, has received funding from the European Research Council (ERC) under the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation program (grant agreement No 714589).

The "ELWarES - Trend File.dta" Stata file contains average expert judgments per political party. The file also contains the number of valid expert judgements and their standard deviation. Parties on the economic left want government to play an active role in the economy. Parties on the economic right emphasize a reduced economic role for government: privatization, lower taxes, less regulation, less government spending, and a leaner welfare state.

"Traditional" or "authoritarian" parties often reject these ideas; they value order, tradition, and stability, and believe that the government should be a firm moral authority on social and cultural issues.
