

SILENT DANGER

There are (fortunately, very rare) situations in which you want to call the emergencies. However, this might be problematic for some reasons:

- If you are hiding from someone with a gun, then you want to tell where you are and briefly what's happening, but clearly you cannot speak.
- If you have a medical emergency, you would like to send the GPS coordinates immediately instead of spelling clearly the name of your street. Or rather than saying vaguely at which point of an highway you are in.
- You may be dumb, or you may not speak fluently a common language with the emergencies.

Today we could have an app to call emergencies, as an alternative method with respect to a phone call.

- GPS coordinates can be sent automatically (for a big building, one may also need to specify the floor one is on).
- One may have the possibility of texting the police in silent mode.
- One may have the possibility to describe with icons (language independent) which kind of danger there is.
- The app could start registering for the police what is happening (camera and/or sound).
- There could be a version of the app that only works for one second and then disappears (a practical version of the international hand signal to indicate that you are in danger).

Technically, all of this is possible. One would need to discuss with the institutions which informations need to be communicated (what, in which order, how,...) and make an "official" app.
