IN MEMORIAM ANJO G. HARRYVAN



Prof. Dr. Anjo G. Harryvan (1957 – 2023) was holder of the Jean Monnet Chair in European Politics and Governance as well as Associate Professor of International Relations at the University of Groningen in the Netherlands. He was a senior member of the 'History and Theory of European Integration' chair group.

After majoring in History at the Free University of Amsterdam and postgraduate work at the EUI in Florence, Prof. Harryvan joined the University of Groningen in 1987. He was one of the founders of the programme Policy and Governance of International Organisations. He contributed to the evolution of this programme into the successful BA programme International Relations and International Organisation and MA programme International Relations.

Prof. Harryvan accumulated 30 years of teaching experience in lecturing European integration and European politics. He successfully published a plethora of books and articles on these subjects, not just for academic discussion but also for the general public.

IN MEMORIAM ANJO G. HARRYVAN

Anjo was a dedicated teacher and researcher, who was respected and appreciated by his students and colleagues. His legacy to European Integration studies remains a valuable source of documentation for researchers and teachers alike.

One of his favourite quotes was: "It's fine to be Dutch, French, Italian, Scottish or whatever we choose to be, but at the end of the day we are all Europeans."

In 2021, he was awarded the Jean Monnet Chair in European Politics and Governance. In his wish to "give back" and reflect on this accolade, Prof. Harryvan organised the first of what was to be an inspiring annual series of Summer Schools on European Policy and Governance.

To our great sadness after an intense struggle with cancer, Anjo Harryvan passed away on the 7th of April 2023. Our thoughts remain with his wife Margaret and daughter Maaïke.
